

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-39

A RESOLUTION, adopting the “SR285 North Wenatchee Avenue Transportation Master Plan” as a guidance document for future comprehensive planning and updates to pertinent city code.

WHEREAS, the Wenatchee Valley Transportation Council (WVTC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the urbanized Wenatchee, East Wenatchee, and Rock Island Region in North Central Washington; and

WHEREAS, the WVTC is responsible for coordinated, comprehensive, long range transportation planning in the Greater Wenatchee metropolitan area.

WHEREAS, Transpo Group was hired by the WVTC to develop a master plan for North Wenatchee Avenue between Miller Street and SR2/SR285 interchange.

WHEREAS, development of the plan was funded with Federal Transportation planning funds.

WHEREAS, the WVTC and consultant established a Corridor Advisory Committee and a Steering committee to engage stakeholders and technical staff in the participation and development of the plan.

WHEREAS, the WVTC Technical Advisory Committee including City of Wenatchee staff participated in technical review of the plan.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation is a member of the WVTC and Department staff participated in technical review of the plan.

WHEREAS, the WVTC held public meetings to share the plan with the public and receive feedback.

WHEREAS, The WVTC adopted the “SR 285 North Wenatchee Transportation Master Plan” on February 10, 2011.

WHEREAS, the plan provides a strategy for addressing the North Wenatchee Avenue Congestion Improvements Corridor need identified in the Wenatchee Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WENATCHEE that the “SR 285 North Wenatchee Transportation Master Plan shall be and hereby is approved as a document to guide future comprehensive planning and updates to pertinent land use regulations.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WENATCHEE at a regular meeting thereof this 24th day of March, 2011.


